- Bef. 29 Dec 1669 b. Plymouth **James** son of Joseph and Elizabeth Howland. [MF 23 Part 1:31]

- 5 Mar 1666/7 Joseph Howland served as Juror. [PCR 8:136]
- 6 Jun 1667 Joseph Howland listed on treasury accounts. [PCR 7:121]
- 2 Jul 1667 Joseph Howland served as Juror. [PCR 8:137]
- Jul 1667 Joseph Howland agreed with the town to find wood for year. [PTR 1:87]
- 13 Oct 1667 Joseph Howland appointed to a committee to assemble items for town meeting. [PTR 1:91]
- 20 Oct 1667 Joseph Howland served as Juror. [PCR 8:141]
- 13 Jan 1667/8 Appointed Joseph Howland standing trooper for the town for a term of 5 years from this date. [PTR 1: 93]
- 3 Jun 1668 Joseph Howland appointed Surveyor of Highways for Plymouth. [PCR 4:181]
- 16 Jun 1668 Joseph Howland voted at the town meeting. His father John had a line through his named. [PTR 1:102]
- 25 Oct 1668 Joseph Howland served as Juror. [PCR 8:150]
- 6 Jul 1669 Joseph Howland served as Juror. [PCR 8:156]

Land Transfers

- 27 Dec 1665 Joseph Howland granted 2 acres at Turkey Swamp (Plympton) [PTR 1:80]
- 31 Jan 1667/8 Joseph Howland granted 30 acres at Indian Pond (Plympton/Kingston) [PTR 1:96]
- 19 Feb 1667/8 The bounds for the 30 Acre grant were laid out at Indian Pond. [PTR 1:96/97]

- 13 Jun 1668 William Crowe measures 50 acres of land in Colchester (Plympton) for John Howland which is next to land purchase by Joseph and his father from Jonathan Bosworth. [PTR 1:104]
- 18 Nov 1669 Thomas Southworth bequest all his housing and lands in Plymouth to his dau. Elizabeth Howland. [PM 442]
- 18 Nov 1669 Thomas Southworth bequest all his lands outside of Plymouth to his dau. Elizabeth and her husband Joseph Howland. [PM 442]
