- 24 May 1660 Plymouth granted to John Howland a tract of land within 2 miles of the Winnetuxet Meadows (Plympton) [PTR 39]
- 1 Apr 1661 John Howland & others purchase land at Saconeesett (Falmouth). [PCLR 2 (2):61 [PCRD V2 P2:61]MD 16:76-78.
- 4 Jun 1661 PCC confirms permission was granted on 5 Mar 1660 to John Howland & others to purchase land in Saconeesett (Falmouth) [PCR 3:216]
- 14 Dec 1661 Agreement between John Howland and John Cook on a change to the property line separating their land at Rocky Nook. Location of house foundation was determined from the old and new property lines defined in this deed. [PCLR 2 (2):74] [PCRD V2 P2:74]
- 22 Aug 1662 John Howland & others purchase land in Saconeesett (Falmouth and Woods Hole) [PCRD V3 P2:319]
- 27 Dec.1665 Jacob Mitchell was granted a garden plot adjoining the homestead of Gyles Rickard Sr. [PTR 1:78/9]
- 1 Jan 1665 John Howland granted share in Pachade Purchase (Middleboro) Lot # 20 [PCRD V3 P1:21] Date grant was recorded. Location was Pachade Neck.
- 7 Jun 1665 John Howland granted 12 acres of land in the Major Purchase (Middleboro). [PCR 4:95]
- 5 Jun 1666 John Howland granted 100 acres in the Major Purchase (Middleboro). [PCR 4:131]
- 22 May 1666 William Crowe Layout 100 acres of land at Namaskett Meadow (Middleboro) for John Howland. [PCLR 3 (1):69] [PCRD V3 P1 :69]
- 5 Mar 1667/8 Court request the land for Edward Gray be layed out the same as John Howland and John Cook, west southwest property line [PCR 4:173]
- Jul 1667 The bounds of a former grant of garden plot or homestead to Jacob Mitchell were laid out SE of Glyes Rickards plot. [PTR 1:89] Now location of Jabez Howland House.
- 28 Aug 1667 Recorded 9 Jan 1670/1 John Howland Gentleman and Elizabeth sold 10 acres in Eastham to John Doane Jr. of Eastham. [PCLR 3 (1b):194] [PCRD V3 P1:194]
- 22 Dec 1667 John and Elizabeth Howland sold their ½ share of land in Ponagansett (New Bedford) to John Almy. [PCLR 4 (1):211] [PCRD V4 P1:211]
- 28 Dec 1667 John Howland Gent: and Elizabeth to John Howland Yeomen of Barnstable a gift of 90 acres and 12 acres of marsh bound by Spring Creek in Barnstable. [PCLR V4 P1:149] [PCRD V4 P1:149]

- 4 Jun 1668 John Howland Yeomen sold John Wing his land in Yarmouth which is bound by Bound Brook and Strong Brook. [PCLR 3 (1):117] [PCRD V3 P1:117]
- 8 Dec 1669 John Howland and other proprietors sign agreement for Edward Gray and others to represent them in drawing the lot boundaries for the Namasket land. (Middleboro) [PCRD V3 P1:170]
