- 8 Jun 1671 John Howland sold 11 acres in Punckateeset Neck (Tiverton, RI) to John Almy. [PCRD V3 P2:329]
- 3 Nov 1671 John Howland Gentleman and William White Planter exchange land between them. John exchanged House/land occupied by John Branch located in Green Harbor, Marshfield for house/ land that William White received from his father Resolved White in Nemasket, (Middleboro). [PCLR 3 (1) 203,204] [V3 P1:203]
- 5 Aug 1672 Jabez Howland granted a lot of land by the Mill Brook next to land given by his father. Also, a lot of meadow ground that runs to the brook. [PTR 126/7]
- 4 Mar 1672/3 Elizabeth Howland gives all land at Nemasket (Middleboro) to John Gorham. [PCR 5:108/9]
- 10 Dec 1672 John Howland Jr. deeded 45 acres of the land in Barnstable given to him by his father in 1667 to John Chipman. [GNBF 1:157]
- 6 Mar 1672/3 John Howland bequeathed to his wife Elizabeth the use and benefit of house and all lands in Plymouth. [PM280]
- 6 Mar 1672/3 John Howland bequeathed to John Howland Jr. one hundred acres lying on the eastern side of the Taunton River (Middleborough). [PM 280]
- 6 Mar 1672/3 John Howland bequeathed to Jabez Howland my land at Satucket (Woods Hole) and Paomett (Truro) and one piece of land on the South side of Mill Brook (Plymouth). [PM 280]
- 6 Mar 1672/3 John Howland bequeathed to Isaac Howland all my land in Middleborough and a tract of land near Nemasket Ponds which I purchase from William White. Also, ½ of a twelve-acre lot at the Winnetuxett River (Plympton). [PM 280]
- 6 Mar 1672/3 John Howland bequeathed to Joseph Howland after decease of his wife Elizabeth his house at Rocky Nook, Plymouth. [PM 280]
- 7 Mar 1672/3 Jonathan Bosworth sold to John Howland deceased, a house and 70-80 acres of land in Colchester (Plympton). [3 (2):288] [V3 P2:388]
- 5 Jun 1673 Jabez and Bethiah sell shares of land at Paomett (Truro) [3 (2):281] [V3 P2:281] [V5 P2:485]
- 4 Jul 1673 John Howland /heirs & John Chipman granted 100 acres in near Taunton border(Middleboro). [PCR 5:127/8]
- 20 Sep 1673 John Howland Jr. testimony on the marsh land boundaries of his father's and his brother Joseph's since 1639. [ PH Testimony of John Howland 20 Sep 1673] [PJHS Digital Archives]
- 16 Feb 1673/74 Jabez Howland was granted 1 acre of land on the top of the hill for his land by the brook so George Bonum may have a way to his mill. [PTR 138]

- 16 Feb 1673/74 John and Desire Gorham sold the land given to them by John and Elizabeth Howland to George Danson. The land was in Nemasket (Middleboro) One parcel was "where the house of John Howland house stood that later burnt down" before the land was sold to George Danson. [PCLR 4(1):108. [PCRD V4 P1:108] See 4 Mar 1672/3.
- 23 May 1674 John Howland recently deceased and John Chipman lands in Middleboro laid out and recorded. [PCLR 3(2):318a] [PCRD V3 P2:318]
- 18 Jun 1679 George Danson sells Middleboro land to Thomas Faunce giving the history of the property including his house that was burnt in the King Philip War. [PCLR 4 (2):290 [PCRD V4 P2:290]
